Bible Point: Jesus loves me! Thank you, Jesus!

Bible Verse: "For the Lord is good; God's love endures forever, and his faithfulness to all generations." Psalm 100:5

Materials Included:

- Tin Can, paper, and popsicle sticks
- Take Home Coloring Sheet

What to do:

- Tin Can Well Pencil Holder: Wrap your tin can with paper and decorate. Write encouraging sayings on the popsicle sticks. Place popsicle sticks in the tin can well to pull out when you need an encouraging word.
- Complete the take home coloring sheet and discuss the Home Huddle Questions below.
- Read together the Spark Story Bible, Woman at the Well on page 420.

Home Huddle Questions: These are designed for parents to follow-up, reinforce, and encourage the VBS concepts at home.

- **Home Huddle Questions:** Today we focused on Jesus' love; how Jesus showed that love by giving water to a Samaritan woman. This water was living water that is a forgiving love and life with God. Our faith is like that, too. By showing this love, we show Jesus.
 - How can you show love to another person? What are ways that you can help someone who might be thirsty? How do we love people we don't know or look different from us?
- **Bible Buddy:** Sunny, the Sun Fish, our Bible buddy for today, reminds us that Jesus loves the whole world, and so can we!
