Safety VBS Procedures

Vacation Bible School is a great way for your kids or family to engage in some good ole outdoor fun while learning about Jesus! Here is how we will keep you or your kids safe:

Important reminders before coming to VBS:

- Please have your child use the bathroom and wash hands thoroughly before coming.
 Bathrooms will be available, when needed.
- If anyone in your household is sick, please keep all children home.
- Each kiddo will need a mask! We have extras if they forget.
- Water bottles! Please provide a water bottle for your kid, and one that they can be responsible for. Water fountains will be closed.
- Register your kids in the same pod and/or with a friend pod. Siblings will be kept together.

During VBS:

- Kids are kids, and we want them to have fun! We will be helping to maintain a physical distance of 6 feet between other crews.
- Hand sanitizer and kleenex will be available at each rotation.
- Sticker name tags will be provided for each child. They will receive new ones each day at check-in.
- Most activities will be large motor skills, family games, storytelling, science experiments, or service projects to do together. If supplies are needed, there will be clean items and a place to put used items. No shared supplies.

After VBS:

- Please have your kid wash their hands upon returning home.
- Please let Ann Masica or Pastor Heather know if your child becomes ill after attending VBS.

What about volunteers?

- Volunteers, like participants, will be wearing a mask at all times.
- Volunteers will have a name tag with their photo on it!
- Volunteers will help keep children physically distanced and safe.
- Volunteers will distribute hand sanitizer after each rotation at each station.
- Volunteers will sanitize each station and any shared objects in between each rotation.
- Volunteers will be in red shirts, easy to ask for help!
