



Jump into Service

Day 4

Bible Point: Jesus remembers me! Thank you, Jesus!

Bible Verse: "God has been faithful in his love...and his saving power is seen everywhere on earth." Psalm 98:3

Materials Needed:

- Tissue box for each participant
- Markers & stickers
- Paper or wrapping paper and tape, if desired.

Set Up:

On a table, set up the tissue boxes, paper, and markers.

What to do:

Introduce it!

- **Say:** Welcome everyone to Jump into Service! In today's Bible Story, the resurrected Jesus appears to Mary Magdalene. Mary recognizes him when Jesus says her name. This recognition shows the relationship and care that Jesus has with all of his followers. Today, we show that same care by decorating tissue boxes for our local nursing home.
- **Ask:** How can a tissue be caring for someone? What does it feel like to not have a tissue to use? What are other ways we can care for our neighbor this summer?

Get to it!

Say: Today we are going to be decorating boxes of tissues to give away. In this activity we show our care and love for our neighbors.

1. Each participant will decorate a bar of soap.
2. Have participants use paper to cover the tissue box so there are places to decorate.
3. Decorate the outer packaging with pictures and words of kindness, faith, neighbor, etc.

Debrief it!

- **Huddle Questions:** Jesus remembers Mary. How do you think Jesus remembers you? How do you remember God's love? What good can a box of tissues do?
- **Practice the Bible Point**
Leader says: Jesus remembers me!
Kids say: Thank you, Jesus!

God Sightings

Invite the participants to take a walk or sit quietly. How does God remember us? What are ways we can care for our neighbor this summer? Where have you seen God today?

Pray it out!

Huddle together and say: Ollie, the Otter, our Bible buddy for today, reminds us that Jesus remembers each one of us!

Dear God, thank you for Jesus for remembering us. Lead me to remember others and to care for all in your name! Thank you, Jesus! Amen.
