### Peace Doves

#### Materials Included:

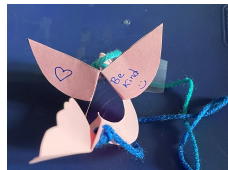
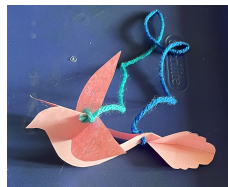
- Paper with Peace Doves printed on it
- Yarn for hanging
- Paper clip

#### Materials from home

- Scissors
- Pens, pencils, crayons or markers to write messages and decorate doves

#### What to do:

- Cut the template into two sections along the black lines to make two birds.
- Fold a section in half along the line.
- Cut the bird shape out around the solid black line.
- Fold the tail piece forwards and backwards along the dotted fold line.
- Cut along the line marking the wings, then cut the wings in half along the center fold.(solid line)
- Gently fold the tail upwards, and the wings outwards so it looks like your bird is flying.
- To add string to the bird, use the paper clip to poke a hole on the centerfold just above the wing. Do the same just below the wing. Cut yarn to desired length and tie.
- Thread a piece of string through each hole and secure.
- You can decorate your doves or add messages of peace and kindness.
- Hang the doves around your house or on a neighbor's door to share the peace.
